



OPENING EVENT FOR THE 8.5km "COOROORA TRAIL"

If you enjoy bushwalking, mountain bike riding or horse riding then this is for you....

WHEN: 8am Sunday 30 November 2008

WHERE: Starting from the Noosa Showgrounds, Exhibition Street, Pomona

WHAT WILL HAPPEN: Walk or ride (bring your own mountain bike or horse) the new 8.5km Cooroora Trail.

The walk/ride will start at the Pomona Showgrounds then meander through Cooroora Creek Park, Tuchekeoi Forest Reserve (around the base of Mt Cooroora), William Martin Park and private property at the base of Mt Cooran before heading to the Cooran Rec Club.

Mountain bike riders will head off as a group first followed by the horse riders and then the walkers.

At the end of your walk/ride refreshments will be available from the Cooran Rec Club.

A shuttle bus will take you back to your car/float at Pomona or you can walk/ride back at your own pace.

Horse riders please note that as the trail follows the road in some sections, crosses the railway line and requires horses to walk across bridges and go through gates both horses and riders must be experienced.

You are also invited to the official opening by the Mayor Bob Abbot at 9.30am on Thursday 20 November at the Pomona Showgrounds.
