Schedule of Conditions

- 1 The Applicant must:
 - a. be registered in the Agricultural Property System (APS);
 - b. if the property is an infected property in a Queensland free or control zone, the property must be undergoing an approved program for cattle ticks;
 - c. not have had an approval in any approved scheme cancelled for any non-compliance with a condition of the approved scheme or of any travel permit issued in accordance with an approved scheme in the 2 years immediately preceding this Application and Agreement;
 - d. successfully complete the Applicant Instruction and Awareness course; and
 - e. member of a DPI&F accredited Organisation.

- 2 To remove any doubt, for a person to be eligible to be an ATCP, there must be an Organisation (accredited with the DPI&F) nominating that person. If an Organisation's accreditation is cancelled after the person is approved as an ATCP, the person approved as an ATCP automatically ceases to be an ATCP.

- 3 If, at anytime the ATCP is no longer a member of the Organisation, the person cannot perform the duties of an ATCP and any approval granted will be cancelled.
- 4 All stock that is to be moved under this scheme must be free of tick.
- 5 This approved scheme applies to:
 - a. the movement of manageable, groomed stock including both primary (cattle, deer & buffalo) and secondary host species (camelids, donkeys, goats, horses, mules and sheep); and
 - b. the movement is a direct conveyance between properties in the Queensland free or control zones to travel to and return from scheduled competition events held at venues in the Queensland infected zone or in the Queensland free or control zones determined as infected status or at risk (high) status.
- 6 All stock presented to an Applicant for treatment **MUST** be accompanied by a travel permit required under section 11 of the *Stock (Cattle Tick) Notice* ("Notice") and a waybill. If a correct travel permit and a correct waybill:
 - a. are not presented, the Applicant must not treat the stock or provide any certification as to any treatment;
 - b. are presented, the Applicant must, subject to Condition 8, treat the stock with an approved chemical (eg acaricide), before leaving the infected zone or an infected or at risk high venue in any other zone.
- 7 All cattle tick treatments must be performed in a manner approved by an inspector appointed under the *Stock Act 1915* ("Inspector") using approved equipment and approved chemicals (eg acaricide), as detailed at the ATCP Instruction and Awareness course and in the associated manual. An inspector may request an inspection of and a demonstration by the Applicant of any such spray equipment and acaricide (or application of it).

Approved acaricide for:

- a. horses, donkeys and mules are Barricade 'S, Blockade 'S or Bayticol Dip & Spray; and
 - b. all other species is amitraz products of Amitik EC Cattle and Pig Spray, Tactic EC Acaricidal Spray for Cattle & Pigs, Amitraz EC Cattle and Pig Spray, Amitik Cattle Dip and Spray, Tactic WP Cattle Dip and Spray, Tickoff WP Cattle Tickicide.
- 8 The Applicant must verify the stock described on the waybill is the stock presented for treatment and the Applicant must then endorse on the waybill the treatment details performed by the Applicant, including:

- a. the Applicant's name;
 - b. all chemical used;
 - c. the place of treatment;
 - d. the date of treatment; and
 - e. signature of the Applicant.
- 9 The Applicant must complete a detailed logbook of all treatments performed and all approved chemicals (eg acaricide) used in the ATCP Scheme.
- 10 The Applicant's rights in this Application and Agreement are personal and not transferable. The Applicant must immediately notify an inspector of any change in circumstances relating to Application and Agreement (eg change in address or contact details).
- 11 Stock moved under this approved scheme must be returned to the property of original as specified below:
- a. manageable and groomed primary host species of stock – within 72 hours of the original forward movement; and
 - b. manageable and groomed secondary host species of stock – within five (5) days of the original forward movement.
- 12 If cattle ticks are found or suspected to be present on any stock presented for treatment to the ATCP, the ATCP must:
- a. notify the nearest Inspector within 24 hours of finding or suspecting the presence of cattle ticks;
 - b. not treat or certify any treatment of cattle tick infested (or suspected to be infested) stock unless authorised by an inspector; and
 - c. not allow tick infested (or suspected to be infested) stock to be moved and such stock must be isolated until authorised to be released by an Inspector.
- 13 At any reasonable time (without giving prior notice to the Applicant), an Applicant must allow an Inspector access to:
- a. any property on which stock moved under an approved scheme are normally depastured; or
 - b. any register, record or documents in relation to such stock; and
 - c. any stock relevant to the approved scheme,
- for the purposes of:
- d. inspecting, auditing and monitoring the property, register, record or any document and the stock;

- e. obtaining samples, including hair or blood from any stock, or sample of any acaricide involved or used in conjunction to an approved scheme; or
 - f. enquiring the Applicant in relation to the property, register, record or any document and the stock.
- 14 An inspector may immediately suspend an Applicant's approval if an inspector believes on reasonable grounds the Applicant or any person acting with the authority of the Applicant has moved stock contrary to the Notice or contravened any conditions of approval.
- 15 An Inspector must:
- a. notify the Applicant and the Organisation of the suspension in writing and provide grounds for the suspension; and
 - b. inform the Applicant that he or she has 28 days after the date of the suspension notice to show grounds why the approval should not be cancelled. The Applicant's submission must be in writing to the Chief Inspector.
- 16 An approval is cancelled if the Applicant:
- a. has not within 28 days of the date of the suspension notice made a written application to the Chief Inspector; or
 - b. the Chief Inspector is not reasonable satisfied with the Applicant's submission.
- 17 If the approval is cancelled, the Chief Inspector must notify the Applicant in writing. In the written notice, the Chief Inspector must inform the Applicant of his or her rights to appeal to the Magistrates Courts under section 36 of the *Stock Act 1915*.
- 18 This Agreement automatically terminates three (3) years after the Applicant is notified in writing of the approval, unless sooner terminated by the Chief Inspector or renewed after the Applicant request in writing to the Chief Inspector no later than 30 days prior to the expiration of the Agreement.
