Purpose: A travel permit issued under this application is for the direct movement of secondary host species of manageable, groomed stock from the Queensland infected zone to scheduled competition events in a Queensland free or control zone and return to the place of origin.

Please Note Conditions of Travel Permit:

The following conditions must be satisfied by the approved applicant:

- The stock must be inspected by the owner or the person in charge of the stock prior to commencing the movement; and
- The stock will be returning to the place of origin within five (5) days. If the stock does not return to the place of origin within 5 days (but no more than fifteen (15) days), the stock will be inspected by an inspector or approved person at a clearing facility before leaving the infected zone.
