Changes to the Fair Work Amendment Act 2013 - Workplace Bullying

Anti-workplace bullying measures came into being on the 1st of January as part of the Fair Work Amendment Act 2013.

The provisions of the Act have an expanded definition of 'a worker' which includes amongst other things, a **volunteer** and considers an employer a 'constitutionally-covered business' (ie a constitutional corporation - a proprietary limited company or an **incorporated association** conducting trading or financial operations).
